"Sing to the Lord a *new* song!", the psalmist writes (Psalm 98). So what does that word *new* mean to you? Soon the new 2018 pennies will be out. We'll notice them because they will be bright and shiny compared to the other old worn ones. Qualities of newness are brightness, freshness, crispness. And add excitement, enthusiasm, and joy. They are the kind of qualities Jesus is talking about when he says, "...that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be full." (John 15: 11)

The good news of the New Testament is *new* news for us every year and every day! The New Testament is full of a proclamation of newness. "This cup is the *new* covenant shed for you for the forgiveness of sin." 
