PASTOR'S LETTER FOR June 2021





"Good to see you!" "It's so good to see your face again!" "I had wondered if you still had a face under that mask so it's good to see that you do!" These are some of the comments that I heard people saying to each other as we gathered last Sunday for the celebration of Pentecost. It was good indeed to see everyone and to hear these comments and see the joy with which everyone gathered and hear the excitement in their voices as the council had followed the new CD guidelines that fully vaccinated people could gather again without masks and without social distancing.

This raises the question of why exactly do we gather? The second lesson from the Sunday also, coincidently, was from Roman 8, where St. Paul writes, "Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what is seen? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience." Well, we waited with hope, didn't we, for the day when we could receive Covid vaccinations and some of the restrictions from this pandemic could be removed. And now we have seen that day! But Paul is speaking of our hope in an unseen God. Who has seen God face to face? The prophet Isaiah sees God in a dream, but most of us have not. But this is exactly why we gather!

We gather every Sunday, as people of faith and hope because, for all of us who believe and hope in an unseen God can see God in the faces of each other! In my daily prayers I prayer for God to "open the eyes of my heart and mind that I may see Jesus and believe in him". This is my prayer for all of you too! And we gather for that reason...that in the "eyes of our hearts and minds" we may see God in each other's' faces!

So, while council did decide to remove some of the restrictions from the pandemic, they also decided to slowly remove others in our worship guidelines since the new cases in our county are still pretty high. Well, we wait with hope don't we? And in the meantime, let us rejoice that we can look for the presence of God in each other's' faces! Thanks be to God!
