FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESK February 2022

Dear Members of Saint James,

On Sunday of February 13, 2022, we will be having a Special Valentine Love Worship Service entitled "All You Need Is Love" given by Peggy Thatcher. Please come and enjoy this special Sunday Service.

As we enter the month of February and look forward to Valentine's Day, we will hear a lot about LOVE! This type of love will be related to romantic love. But do we really understand love? Let us see what Jesus has to say about love. "This is my commandment, that you love one another as I have loved you. ¹³ No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends" John 15:12-13. 
