FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESK October 2022

The Reformation occurred on the same day as Halloween, October 31. The Reformation occurred when Martin Luther nailed the 95 Thesis to the door of Wittenberg's All Saint Church in 1517. Luther posted these 95 Thesis on the day before All Saints Day on November 1, one of the most Holy Days in the Church Calendar. Halloween comes from the celebration of All Hallow Eve which is the evening before All Saint Day when it is said that demons and evil spirits walk the earth. We are so immersed into worldly culture and celebrations that we have missed the celebration of a very important anniversary in the Protestant Church. The Reformation was the birth of all Protestant Denominations.




Worship Guidelines
