

#### **Pastor's May Musings**

The Spirit is on the move

The time after Easter is always a unique one, especially in the life of the church. We just come off of the Easter experience which we have been preparing for weeks, we take part in the all the additional services (especially with Holy Week), we put the extra energy into special music and activities for Easter and then it's done. We begin to wonder what is next. Many churches tend to move on with their church lives and we see the mark downs on Easter decorations and candies in stores but the celebration of Easter continues until Pentecost (which is Memorial Day weekend if you are thinking ahead). I will say that, so far, I have seen various ways in which the Spirit bubbling up at St James and I am interested where those conversations will continue to arise.

Let us take, this new season of the year & church to hear and join in the moving Spirit which Jesus promises to join with us.
