# FROM THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT'S DESK February 2025

Dear Members of St. James:

Grace, mercy and peace from God, our Father, and our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. As we enter into the month of February, we will discover that there are two holidays in February, Groundhog Day and Valentine's Day. Groundhog Day comes from a tradition of Northern Europe in which when an animal on February 2<sup>nd</sup> comes out of its lair after hibernation to either to see or not see its shadow. If the animal sees its shadow, then winter is not over and there will be 6 more weeks of winter; but if the animal does not see its shadow, then spring has arrived.

Groundhog Day reminds me so much of the Christian prospective of death and the second Coming of Jesus Christ. If we as Christians are the Groundhog and we have died, and we are coming out of our lairs or in other words out of the grave after our hibernation or sleep of death at Christ's Second Coming. Therefore, if we too come out of the grave at the Second Coming and we see our shadow which is our sin. We too will then return to the grave and into the second death because our sin has condemned us, and we will remain in the grave until the Final Judgement. But if we wake from our sleep of death at the Second Coming of Jesus Christ and find that there is no shadow because our sins have been forgiven through the death and resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Then the winter of our death is over, and we can spring into Eternal life through the resurrection of the dead and we can enter the Kingdom of Heaven with Christ.

This gift of grace was given to us not because of something that we have done, but because of God's great love for us that He did not want us to be condemned, but to have eternal life with Him. This is such a precious gift that we should never take for granted.




